## Dr. John Inman

Dr. John Emerson Inman passed away unexpectedly from a blood clot in the heart at home in Monroe, WI on Friday, September 16, 2011. Dr. Inman was born on August 24, 1942 at Mercy Hospital in Janesville, WI. He grew up on the family farm in Clinton, WI and moved with his mother to Janesville in middle school after the death of his father. John graduated from Janesville high school in 1960 and attended Carroll College where he was a member of Delta Rho Upsilon fraternity. He graduated in 1964 with a bachelors of science in chemistry. John then earned his Masters in zoology from the University of Miami (Florida) followed by his M.D. from Marquette Medical School/Medical College of Wisconsin.
