SCOUT RELEASE REQUEST

A Scout desiring to leave the camp prior to their unit's departure, or not as part of a unit, must have a release signed by their parent or guardian and approved by the Scoutmaster. Scouts should normally only be permitted to leave accompanied by their parents. The form below should be used in handling these exceptional cases.

In an emergency, it may not be possible for a parent or guardian to sign the release. In this event, sufficient information must be recorded attesting to the telephone call or means of communication by which word arrived asking for the release of the Scout. This information should document the person from whom the call was received, verify telephone confirmation of the parent asking for release of the Scout, and giving detailed reasons for the release.
